


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REVIEW ON BALATANTRA - A GREAT TREATISE

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ABSTRACT

Kaumarbhritya is one branch of Astangayurveda that deals with children's diseases and their treatment up to 16 years old. There are not many textbooks belongs to Kaumarbhritya in the Ayurveda. Only a few texts i.e., Kashyap Samhita, Balatantra, Kumartantra has been available nowadays. Kashyap Samhita is a well-known textbook for pediatrics diseases and treatments in ayurveda, but Balatantra has not been commonly used and studied. Balatantra has also a detailed description of the care and diseases of Kumar i.e., Up to 16 years children. Therefore, this article is trying to draw attention to Balatantra'Shreyansa' hindi commentary so that some invaluable knowledge is added to commonly usable Ayurveda pediatric science.

INTRODUCTION

Kaumarbhitya or *Ayurveda* pediatrics deals with the care of children and diseases which harass the child during childhood till 16th years. This branch also gives information about protection along with the treatment of many diseases. A series of books on ayurveda pediatrics are *Kashyap Samhita*, *Balatan*-

tra, Kumartantra, etc. Balatantra is one of the important treatises composed by Shree Kalyana Vaidhya. In this treatise Astangayurveda's three parts i.e., Kaumarabhritya, Bhutavidya, and Vajikarana have been described. There are more than 800 quotations has been mentioned in this treatise. Baltantra

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has been divided into a total of 14 *Patala*(chapters). *Baltantra* has been written by shree kalyana vaidhya ji who was the grandson of Shree Ramdas Vaidhya and son of Shree Mahidhara Vaidhya. This treatise had been formed in samvat 1644 vikrami shravanshukla purnima on Sunday at a place called shivalaya. Probably this place has been now at near agara(up) known as 'sevala' town. *Balatantra* '*Shreyansa*' hindi commentary has been written by hindi commentator Shree Abhay Katyayan. This manuscript was published by Choukhamba surbharati prakashan, Varanasi in 2019.

Aim and Objectives: To provide a brief introduction of *Balatantra* '*Shreyansa*' hindi commentary.

Material and Method: -

References have been collected from the ancient textbook of *Kaumarabhritya* (*Ayurveda* pediatrics) i.e., '*Shreyansa*' hindi commentary of *balatantra* which has been written on Shree Kalyana Vaidhyakruta *Balatantra*.

Division of Balatantra: -

Entire *Balatantra* is composed of *Patalas* i.e., Chapters which is 14th in numbers.

14 Patala are as Follows: -

Patala Discussion

Shodash Bandhyapratikara Kathana¹

In this chapter after invocation *Acharya* has mentioned about eight types of sterility defect of women i.e., *Raktadosha Janya reproductive defects*, *Pit-*

tadoshaja defect, Vatadoshaja, Kaphadoshaja reproductive defects, Tridoshaja defects, Grahadoshaja, Devaprakopa Janya, and Abhichar or Shapajanya reproductive defects. Acharya has also mentioned the 9th reproductive defect of men i.e., *Retoheena* (lack of semen).

Types of sterility in women have been described as *Kakbandhya, Mrutavatsa, Gharbhasravi*, etc. Other than these types of symptoms and treatments of *Devprakopajanya Bandhya, Krutyakrutabandhya*, and *Bandhyashtaka* are described. In *Bandhyashtaka* i.e., *Tripakshi Bandhya, Shubhrati Bandhya, Sajja, Trimukhi, Vyaghrini, Baki, Kamalini* and *Vyaktini Bandhya*, 8 types of sterility's symptoms and treatment are mentioned. Types of vitiated menstruation period (*Dushita Aartava*) and their symptoms, treatment like *Aushadha*(medicine), *Pooja*(worship), *Dana*(charity), *Vrata* (fast), etc are mentioned.

Sadharana Bandhaushadha Kathana²

Acharya has mentioned about conception remedies or yoga for sterile women these are Sankhapushpi Tantram, Shwetakulitthadi Yoga, Ashwagandhatantram, Garbhadharaka Yoga, Bijapoor Prayoga, Gharbhadharana Yoga, Pippalyadi Yonigata, Triphaladi Yoni Vartika, Shunthyadibyonivarti, Yonilepa, Bandhya Nashak Yoga, Erandadi Yoga, Ashwagandha Kashaya, Lakshmanatantram, Lalashtantram, Karanjadi Yoga,

Vasamooltantram, Putranjivakatantram, Swetakantakaritantram, Siddhakalyanak Ghrita. Acharya has also described about four remedies or Yoga for contraception.

Purushvirya Vriddhi Kathana³

Acharya has mentioned about Vajikarana Yoga for a sexually weak or inactive person. The therapy which provides strength, potency, virility, sexual excitement, erection of sexual organ, and pleasure in the intercourse is known as Vajikarana(aphrodisiac). Aphrodisiacs therapy for men has been described as Vajikarana Yoga, Kapikachchhu Prayoga, Vajikarana Prayoga, Dhatakyadi Yoga, Kapikachchhu Kadibyoga, Suratagni Pradipak Yoga, Mashadi Yoga, Dhatri Churnam, Shatavari Tailam, Bastand Yoga, Vidarichurna Yoga, Aamalaki Churna Yoga,

Swayamguptadi Yoga, Uchchatachurna Yoga, Madhuyashti Churna Prayoga, Mushalyadi Yoga, Gokshuradi Churnam, Varahikandafi Modak, Musha-Vriddha Shalmali Churnam. Swaras. Triphaladhyayaleha, Shatayaryadi Churnam, Vi-Churnam. *Khasphalashunthi* Kwath. shada Jatiphaladi Vatika, Kanchanadi Lepa, Ahiphena Yoga, Stridravan Lepa, Stridravan Lepa, Kasisadi Shishnalepa, etc and for women aphrodisiacs therapy Yonisankochaka Vartika and Yonisankochaka Prakshalan is described.

Garbhadhankala me rudrasnana kathana⁴

In this chapter *Acharya* has mentioned about woman and men treated with *Aushadh* (medicines), *Aahar* (diet) and *Vihar* should be tried for conception in auspicious Nakshatra and time. *Acharya* has also described intaking sugar candy milk and *Vajikarana Aushadh* (aphrodisiac medicines) before conception. There is also a description of *Lakshmana* medicine intake, *Rudrasnan* and its procedure. A man or woman who has performed rudrasnan gets prosperity with a lot of offspring.

Garbhini Garbha Raksha Kathana⁵

In this chapter, *Acharya* has mentioned mother and fetus protection procedures (*Garbhini* and *Garbharaksha Vidhi*) from conception to twelve months of gestation age. Various types of formulations have been described for protecting the fetus from abortion and some formulations have been mentioned to help treat troubles like pain etc which are

faced by a pregnant woman during pregnancy period 1st month to 12th month of pregnancy.

Sukhprasava Upaya Kathana⁶

The 6th Patala Acharya has been described as Uninterrupted delivery, Raksha Mantra (chanting and remedies for protection) for the mother after delivery. Karanjadi Taila Pichu, Kantakaribtantram, Apamargamoola Prayoga, Kaliharimoola Prayoga, Sinduwarpatra Prayoga, Shaliparnimoola Prayoga, these all formulations for Yonilepa. Some formulations have been described to apply on navel like Vrishamoolparpatpatra Prayoga, Langali Kakamachi Prayoga, Rubukadi Prayoga, Mayuradi Nabhipralepa. Acharya has been instructed to tie up Dhaturmooltantram on the head. Gunjamooltantram and Swetasharpunkhamooltantram were both instructed to tie up on the loin region (waist). Sarpakanchukadi for vaginal fumigation & Matulungachutnam and Ashwathmool Prayoga both for internal use, Netra Baladi Taila has been described for massage of pregnant women.

Dingrahigrahita Balaraksha Kathana⁷

In this chapter, *Acharya* has mentioned protection (*Raksha*) for a child from birth's 1st day to 10th day. Different symptoms of various *Balagraha* (evil spirits and microorganisms) and their treatment have been mentioned. *Pralepa*(poultice),

Dhupana (fumigation), Bali (immolate), Snan (bathing), Dan (charity), etc have been described in the management of all Grahas individually.

Masagrahigrahita Balaraksha Kathana⁸

In 8th *Patala Acharya* has described various *Balagrahi* which affect the infant per month and also has mentioned about their preventive procedurs like *Bali* etc. These preventive procedurs which are beneficial for children are the following: -

Varshagrahigrahita Balaraksha Kathana⁹

In the 9th *Patala Acharya* has mentioned protective procedures (*Raksha Vidhi*) for children from 1st years of age to 16th years of age and also described *Balagraha* symptoms according to year.

The 10th Patala Acharya has mentioned about symptoms of 16 types of Putanas which affect from 1st day, month, year to 16th day, month, year respectively. These Putanas are Nandini, Sunandini, Putana/Ahiputana, Mukhamandika, Vidalika, Shatkarika, Kalika, Kamini, Madana, Revati, Sudarshana, Adbhuta, Bhadrakali, Tara, Hunkarika and Kumarika. Acharya has also described their preventive aspect like Murti Nirman (idol-making), Bali, Pooja, Snan, Dhupan, etc.

Samanya Balagraharaksha Kathana¹¹

In the 11th Patala Acharya has mentioned Sadharana Balagraha and diseases. Balagraha which affect any time or day or month instead of a specific day, month, and year, they called Sadharana Balagraha. These are Putana, Maha Putana, Urdhva Putana, Bala Kanta, Revati Graha, Maravedi Graha, Pushpa Revati, Shushka Revati, Shakuni Graha, Shishumundika Graha. Acharya has described general symptoms of all balagraha and their treatment like Aushadh, Dhupan, Lepan Mantra, Abhisheka Mantra, Dhupan Mantra, Balaraksha Mantra, Sarvagrahahar Mantra and Sarvagraha Nivaraka Mantra.

Jwaraharna Upaya Kathana¹²

In the 12th Patala Acharya has mentioned Stanyavardhaka or Stanyajanana (galactogogue) Yoga, Dhatri Lakshana, Stanyashodhana Aushadh Yoga, Balak Roga Parikshana, Dhatri Langhana, Nabhipaka (omphalitis) Chikitsa, Sadhyojata Shishu Aruchi Nivarana Aushadh, Gudapaka Chikitsa, Mukhapaka (stomatitis) Chikitsa, massaging of children, Drush tidosha Nivarana. Aushadh Yoga and Jwaranashaka Mantra are mentioned in reference to Jwarachikitsa.

Sadharana Dosha-Chikitsa Kathana¹³

In the 13th Patala Acharya has mentioned various types of diseases which affect the child. These are Balatisara (infantile diarrhoea), Aamatisar, Jwaratisar, Grahani, Arsha Roga (piles), Ajirna (indigestion), Visuchika, Bhasmaka (bulimia), Chhardi (vomiting), Trishna, Hikka (hiccough), 5 types of kasa(cough), Krimiroga (worms), Panduroga(anemia), Kshayaroga, Swarabheda (hoarseness of voice), Arochaka(anorexia), Murchchha (syncope), Daha (burning), Unmada (insanity), Apasmara Vaatvyadhi(nerveous (apilepsy), diseases), Raktapitta (haemoptysis), Udavarta, Hrudaroga (ca rdiac diseases), Mutrakrichcha (dysuria), Mutraghata, Antravriddhi , Gandamala (scrofula), Sheetala *Masurika*(smallpox & chickenpox).

Nanaprayoga Kathana¹⁴

In the 14th *Patala Acharya* has described *Netraroga Chikitsa* (ophthalmology), *Karnarogachikitsa* (audiology and audio surgery), *Nasarogachikitsa* (treatment of nasal diseases), *Shiroroga & Mukhroga Chikitsa*, *Dantashula*, *Aushthaprakopa*, *Muk, Sarpadivisha Chikitsa*, *Vrishchikachikitsa*, *Shwanvisha Chikitsa*. *Rasayana Bheshaja*(medicines) has been also mentioned by *Acharya*.

Limitations of the Text

In this, treatment of some diseases occurring in children has been given, but the diagnosis; symptoms, etc. of those diseases are not fully described.

There are much such yoga or sacrificial deeds or incense in this book, which is not possible to do in today's context.

CONCLUSION

Acharya has mentioned all treatment from before conception, during the pregnancy period, and after delivery. In balatantra some formulations have been described to get virtuous offspring. Acharya has also talked about reproductive defects or sterility & their treatment for conception.

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
